Use by non-Eastrose members and for-profit organizations

No use shall interfere with, or be in conflict with, the Mission of Eastrose or the Principles and Purposes of the Unitarian Universalist Association.

Weddings	Includes use of chapel, sound system, hallway, restrooms and our Quiet Room on the day of the wedding. By prior arrangement, this may also include access for decorating and rehearsal the day before the wedding. This fee does not include the services of a minister or any decorations. The fee is based on total access time, including wedding, of three hours. The additional fee for extended access is \$ 100 per hour.	\$ 300

Sexton Fee	Unless otherwise arranged in advance, an Eastrose sexton must be on the premises at all times during your event(s).	\$ 15/hour
Additional Guidelines	<p>Additional time will be charged at the rented room's regular hourly rate.</p> <p>Classrooms can usually be rented only if the Chapel and/or Thatcher Room is also being rented.</p> <p>Eastrose events and members have first priority to the use of the facility. No use should interfere with, or be in conflict with, the <u>Mission of Eastrose</u> or the <u>Principles and Purposes of the Unitarian Universalist Association</u>.</p>	
Recurring/ Long-term Rentals	If your organization is interested in renting space from Eastrose on an on-going and/or long-term basis, please contact the Eastrose office to discuss fees.	
Non-Profit Groups	Fees for non-profit groups are evaluated on a case-by-case basis. Eastrose considers the nature of the group, its mission, its need and its impact on our facilities.	
Deposits	Cleaning and damage deposit if NO food and/or beverages are served	\$ 100
.	Cleaning and damage deposit if food and/or beverages ARE served	\$ 250
Parking Area	There is no additional charge for parking for an event that is occurring at Eastrose. If a potential user wants to rent <u>only</u> the parking area and grounds for an outside event, fees begin at \$50.	\$ 50 and up
Eastrose Members	Members are not charged a fee for their use of Eastrose facilities for private events. Of course, donations for such use are always welcome and appreciated.
